CHAPTER 87

(House Bill 1255)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County - Sheriff - Salary

FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the Sheriff of Dorchester County; and providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the incumbent Sheriff.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-309.

(a) The sheriff of a county and his deputies shall receive the annual salaries provided by this section for performing the duties required of them by the Constitution and the laws of this State. They shall be reimbursed for expenses as provided by law.

(k) (1) The Sheriff of Dorchester County shall receive a salary of [\$25,000] \$35,000, and be allowed the actual cost of the maintenance of automobiles and the county jail. The Sheriff shall appoint a chief deputy sheriff, one assistant deputy
