SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 94

(House Bill 562)

AN ACT concerning

Higher Education - Private Donation Incentive Program

FOR the purpose of establishing a Private Donation Incentive Program; setting forth how a certain match will be determined and certain payments made; requiring that the payments to certain institutions not exceed a certain amount; establishing certain eligibility criteria; requiring certain foundations to provide certain information annually; defining certain terms; providing for the application of certain funds; requiring the State to meet a certain maintenance of effort requirement; prohibiting certain funds from being included in the computation of a certain type of aid; providing for the administration of a certain program; terminating a certain program after a certain date; and generally relating to a Private Donation Incentive Program for higher education institutions.
