SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Education

2-202.

- (a) The State Board consists of [9]  $\frac{1}{2}$   $\frac{1}{2}$  members, and 1 nonvoting student member, appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
- (b) (1) In making appointments to the State Board, the Governor shall consider representation from:
  - (i) All parts of this State; and
- (ii) Areas of this State with concentrations of population or unique needs.
- (2) The members of the Board shall be appointed from the general public.
- (3) The following individuals may not be appointed to the Board:
- (i) Except for the nonvoting student member, any individual who is subject to the authority of the Board;
  - (ii) The Governor; and
  - (iii) The State Superintendent.
- (4) The student member shall be selected by the Governor from among the following 4 nominees:
- (i) 2 persons nominated by the Maryland Association of Student Councils; and
- (ii) 2 persons nominated by the Governor's
  Youth Advisory Council.
