- (d) (l) Each member serves for a term of [5] 4 years and until a successor is appointed and qualifies. These terms are staggered as required by the terms of the members serving on the State Board as of July 1, [1978] 1989.
- [(2) The seven members serving on the State Board $\,$ as of June 30, 1976 are:
- (i) Members of the Board for the remainder of their terms; and
- (ii) Eligible for reappointment to the same extent as on June 30, 1976.
- [(3)] (2) The Governor shall appoint a new member to fill any vacancy on the Board for the remainder of that term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- [(4)] (3) A member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve for more than two full [5-year] 4-YEAR terms.
- [(5)] (4) The student member shall serve for a term of l year. A student member is eligible for reappointment but may not serve more than 2 full l-year terms.
