- (III) THE OVERALL PLAN FOR ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THIS STATE.
- (2) This annual report shall be printed in sufficient quantities for general distribution in this State.
- (R) (1) THE STATE BOARD SHALL COORDINATE THE OVERALL GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION IN THIS STATE.
- (2) IN CONSULTATION WITH THE SUPERINTENDENT SCHOOLS, THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND PERIODICALLY UPDATE AN OVERALL PLAN CONSISTENT WITH THE BYLAWS THAT SHALL IDENTIFY:
- (I) THE PRESENT AND FUTURE NEEDS OF ELEMENTARY SECONDARY EDUCATION THROUGHOUT THE STATE, INCLUDING A DISCUSSION OF THE DEMOGRAPHIC COMPOSITON OF THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY POPULATION;
- (II) THE PRESENT AND FUTURE CAPABILITIES OF THE PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION SYSTEM IN THIS STATE;
- (III) THE SHORT-RANGE AND LONG-RANGE OBJECTIVES AND PRIORITIES FOR ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION AND METHODS AND TIMELINES FOR ACHIEVING AND MAINTAINING THEM: AND
- (IV) WHETHER CURRENT PROGRAMS ADEOUATELY PREPARE GRADUATES FOR EMPLOYMENT OPPPORTUNITIES IN THIS STATE, AND/OR, OR POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES:-;
- THE STATUS AND NEEDS OF THE VOCATIONAL (V) TECHNICAL EDUCATION PROGRAM, THE VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM, AND THE LIBRARY SYSTEM OF THESE PROGRAMS;
- (VI) THE TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS THAT WOULD ENHANCE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION THROUGHOUT THE STATE;
- (VII) METHODS TO UPGRADE AND IMPROVE TEACHER EDUCATION AND TEACHER CERTIFICATION PROGRAMS;
- ELOW THE STATEWIDE TEST AVERAGES AND SHALL ASSESS THE OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO IMPROVE THE TEST AVERAGES OF THESE SCHOOL SYSTEMS;
- THE METHODS TO IMPROVE THE DIAGNOSIS OF BASIC READING SKILL DEFICIENCIES OF ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS AND TO IMPROVE THE LITERACY RATES OF THESE STUDENTS;
- (X) THE METHODS TO INCREASE THE RATE OF RETENTION AND GRADUATION OF SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS;
