- (10) 5 persons including representatives of community, parent, or religious groups or organizations who have interest or expertise in matters pertaining to adolescent pregnancy and parenting; [and]
- (11) 2 representatives of local government in areas with a significant incidence of adolescent pregnancy; AND
- THE TIME OF APPOINTMENT, REGULARLY ENROLLED AND IN GOOD STANDING IN A HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- (b) (1) The term of a member appointed pursuant to subsection (a)(9), (10), and (11) of this section shall be 3 years.
- SUBSECTION (A)(12) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE 2 YEARS.
- (2) (3) The terms of members appointed pursuant to subsection (a)(9), (10),-and-(11), (11), AND (12) of this section shall be staggered as-required-by-the-terms-provided-for-public members-on-[July-17-1986] JULY-17-1989.
- +3) (4) At the end of a term, a member shall continue to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies.
- (4) (5) A member who is appointed pursuant to subsection (a)(9), (10), and—($\pm\pm$) (11), AND 0R (12) of this section after a term has begun shall serve only for the rest of the term or until a successor is appointed.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members of the Governor's Council on Adolescent Pregnancy currently appointed pursuant to Section 15-202(a)(9), (10), and (11), and (12) of the Family Law Article shall expire as follows:
 - (1)--3-members-in-1990;
 - (2)--3-members-in-1991;-and
 - (3)--4-members-in-1992-
