CHAPTER 135

(Senate Bill 458)

AN ACT concerning

State Police - Information on Racial, Religious, or Ethnic Incidents

FOR the purpose of requiring local law enforcement agencies and the State Fire Marshal to provide certain information on racial, religious, or ethnic incidents to the Maryland State Police; and requiring the Maryland State Police to adopt procedures for the collection and analysis information.
