Marshal and include the information in its analyses] EACH LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY AND THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL SHALL PROVIDE THE DEPARTMENT THE INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.

(3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR THE COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS OF INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
