REGULATION THAT RELATES TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AT PUBLIC LANDINGS IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE FINED NOT MORE THAN \$500.

(III) THE COUNTY ROADS BOARD MAY AUTHORIZE ONE OR MORE EMPLOYEES OF THE QUEEN ANNE'S COUNTY RECREATION AND PARKS TO ISSUE CITATIONS FOR VIO DEPARTMENT TO ISSUE CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE REGULATIONS THAT DEAL WITH THE PARKING OF VEHICLES AT PUBLIC LANDINGS.
