

Commissioners approve, at salaries set by the County Commissioners of at least \$4,200. The Commissioners may appoint an assistant deputy sheriff, at a salary set by the County Commissioners of at least \$4,200.

(2) [The Sheriff shall receive an annual allowance of \$2,500 for the services of a cook for the county jail.] The salaries [and expense allowances] are in lieu of all expenses, fees, costs, and charges, except for the board and keeping of prisoners in the county jail and other necessary operating expenses allowed by law or practice, including all expenses for transferring persons to and from penal institutions, places of confinement and State institutions in the State under sentence or order of an authority.

(3) Before assuming the duties of the office, each deputy sheriff appointed under this subsection shall give bond to the Sheriff in the penalty of \$5,000. The premiums of the bond shall be paid by the county.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
