(5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the Washington County Commissioners shall provide at least an equal and matching fund of \$1.7000. No part of an applicant's matching fund may be provided, either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. The Washington County Commissioners have until June 1, 1991, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that the matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. If this evidence is not presented by June 1, 1991, the proceeds of the loan shall be applied to the purposes authorized in § 8-129 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 207

(House Bill 480)

AN ACT concerning

Washington County - Alcoholic Beverages Theater Licenses

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Washington County Board of License Commissioners to issue a Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale license for use in theaters that meet certain qualifications; establishing qualifications for the license; providing for the scope of this license; establishing an annual license fee; and generally relating to the issuance of a Class B beer, wine and liquor on-sale license for use in certain theaters in Washington County.
