LAWS OF MARYLAND

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

19.

- (w)(1) In Washington County the annual fee for this license is \$500.
- (2) (I) THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A CLASS B BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR ON-SALE LICENSE FOR USE IN A THEATER.
- (II) TO QUALIFY FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH THE THEATER SHALL:
- ORGANIZATION; 1. BE OPERATED BY A NONPROFIT
- 2. APPEAR ON THE NATIONAL REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES;
- 3. ACCOMMODATE AT LEAST 1,400 PERSONS;
- 4. BE LOCATED ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF HAGERSTOWN.
- (III) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH IS \$200.
- (IV) THE HOLDER OF A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH IS AUTHORIZED TO SELL BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION ONLY TO PERSONS WHO ARE ATTENDING A PERFORMANCE OR AN EVENT THAT IS HELD AT THE THEATER.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
