- (iii) [\$30] \$50 $\frac{$45}{}$ for a real estate salesperson license; and
- (5) submit to the Commission any additional information or documentation that the Commission requires. 4-314.
- (d) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:
 - (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
 - (2) pays to the Commission a renewal fee of:
- (i) [\$80] $\$ \pm \theta \theta \pm 95$ for a real estate broker license;
- (ii) [\$50] \$70 $\frac{$65}{}$ for an associate real estate broker license; or
- (iii) [\$30] $$5\theta$ \$45 for a real estate salesperson license;
- (3) submits to the Commission a renewal application on the form that the Commission provides;
- (4) submits to the Commission a certificate of completion verifying that the licensee has complied with the continuing education requirements under § 4-315 of this subtitle; and
- (5) notifies the Commission of the name of each real estate broker with whom the licensee then is affiliated.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Business Occupations

An applicant for a license:

- (1) shall submit to the Commission an application on the form that the Commission provides;
- (2) if a testing service was used to administer the examination, shall submit to the Commission a copy of the examination results of the applicant;
