

salesperson or an associate real estate broker on the granting of an additional license to the licensee;

(3) if currently licensed as a real estate salesperson or an associate real estate broker, submit to the Commission a copy of the written notice informing each real estate broker with whom the licensee currently is affiliated that the licensee intends to affiliate with an additional real estate broker or obtain a real estate broker license;

(4) pay to the Commission an application fee of:

(i) [\$80] ~~\$100~~ \$95 for a real estate broker license;

(ii) [\$50] ~~\$70~~ \$65 for an associate real estate broker license; or

(iii) [\$30] ~~\$50~~ \$45 for a real estate salesperson license; and

(5) submit to the Commission any additional information or documentation that the Commission requires.

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(d) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2-year term, if the licensee:

(1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;

(2) pays to the Commission a renewal fee of:

(i) [\$80] ~~\$100~~ \$95 for a real estate broker license;

(ii) [\$50] ~~\$70~~ \$65 for an associate real estate broker license; or

(iii) [\$30] ~~\$50~~ \$45 for a real estate salesperson license;

(3) submits to the Commission a renewal application on the form that the Commission provides;

(4) submits to the Commission a certificate of completion verifying that the licensee has complied with the continuing education requirements under § 16-315 of this subtitle; and

(5) notifies the Commission of the name of each real estate broker with whom the licensee then is affiliated.
