requirements an original applicant must meet, the board shall amend its records and issue a new license with the corrected names on it. The corporation or club shall pay a fee of \$100 to the board of license commissioners for the service. The fee for a transfer and for assignment of a license is the greater of \$50 or 25 percent of the annual fee of the license being transferred in addition to the cost of publication, notice, and any hearing fees required.

- (2) IN WORCESTER COUNTY, IN ADDITION TO THE RESTRICTIONS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, BEFORE AN OWNER OF A BUSINESS THAT IS LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE MAY TRANSFER OR ASSIGN ANY PECUNIARY INTEREST IN THAT LICENSED BUSINESS:
- (I) THE OWNER SHALL FIRST NOTIFY THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF THE PROPOSED TRANSFER OR ASSIGNMENT; AND
- (II) THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS SHALL APPROVE THE TRANSFER OR ASSIGNMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
