additional fee based on the scale of fees applicable to a certificate inspection of the boiler is charged.

- (5) All other inspections, including shop inspections and inspections of secondhand or used boilers or pressure vessels made by the chief boiler inspector or a deputy boiler inspector are charged at the rate of not less than \$60 for one-half day of four hours and \$100 for one full day of eight hours, plus all expenses, including traveling and hotel. "Secondhand" means an object which has changed ownership and location after primary use.
- (6) In lieu of any other fee schedules under this section, all antique boilers or pressure vessels used in exhibits or shows are charged \$5.]
