SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

150.

- (b) In Charles County, the Board of County Commissioners shall appoint three persons, designating one of them as chairman, who shall constitute the board of license commissioners for said county; the first members of said board to be appointed for one, two and three year terms, respectively, and their successors thereafter for terms of [three] FOUR years each; and said board shall meet at least once a month.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
