5-314. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

(A) NOTICE TO CERTAIN QUALIFIED APPLICANTS.

EXCEPT FOR AN APPLICANT FOR A COSMETOLOGIST-AIDE LICENSE, IF AN APPLICANT QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD SHALL SEND THE APPLICANT A NOTICE THAT STATES THAT:

- (1) THE APPLICANT HAS QUALIFIED FOR THE LICENSE; AND
- (2) THE BOARD WILL ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT ON RECEIPT OF:
- (I) A CERTIFICATE THAT IS MADE UNDER OATH BY AN AUTHORIZED PHYSICIAN AND CERTIFIES THAT THE APPLICANT IS FREE FROM ANY INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE THAT PRESENTS A HAZARD TO A BEAUTY SALON PATRON; AND

(II) A LICENSE FEE OF:

1. \$25 FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE COSMETOLOGY;

2. \$25 FOR A LIMITED LICENSE;

3. \$50 FOR A LICENSE TO TEACH

4. \$50 FOR A LICENSE TO MANAGE A BEAUTY SALON.

(B) ISSUANCE.

COSMETOLOGY: OR

- (1) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A COSMETOLOGIST-AIDE LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT FOR THAT LICENSE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (2) ON RECEIPT OF THE CERTIFICATE OF AN AUTHORIZED PHYSICIAN AND PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE FEE, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH OTHER APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) CONTENTS.

THE BOARD SHALL SEAL EACH LICENSE THAT THE BOARD ISSUES WITH ITS OFFICIAL SEAL.
