5-314. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

(A) NOTICE TO CERTAIN QUALIFIED APPLICANTS.

EXCEPT FOR AN APPLICANT FOR A COSMETOLOGIST-AIDE LICENSE, IF AN APPLICANT QUALIFIES FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD SHALL SEND THE APPLICANT A NOTICE THAT STATES THAT:

(1) THE APPLICANT HAS QUALIFIED FOR THE LICENSE; AND

(2) THE BOARD WILL ISSUE THE LICENSE TO THE APPLICANT ON RECEIPT OF:

(I) A CERTIFICATE THAT IS MADE UNDER OATH BY AN AUTHORIZED PHYSICIAN AND CERTIFIES THAT THE APPLICANT IS FREE FROM ANY INFECTIOUS OR CONTAGIOUS DISEASE THAT PRESENTS A HAZARD TO A BEAUTY SALON PATRON; AND

(II) A LICENSE FEE OF:

1. \$25 FOR A LICENSE TO PRACTICE
COSMETOLOGY;

2. \$25 FOR A LIMITED LICENSE;

3. \$50 FOR A LICENSE TO TEACH
COSMETOLOGY; OR

4. \$50 FOR A LICENSE TO MANAGE A BEAUTY
SALON.

(B) ISSUANCE.

(1) THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A COSMETOLOGIST-AIDE LICENSE TO EACH APPLICANT FOR THAT LICENSE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) ON RECEIPT OF THE CERTIFICATE OF AN AUTHORIZED PHYSICIAN AND PAYMENT OF THE APPROPRIATE LICENSE FEE, THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO EACH OTHER APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) CONTENTS.

THE BOARD SHALL SEAL EACH LICENSE THAT THE BOARD ISSUES WITH ITS OFFICIAL SEAL.
