(1) THE NUMBER OF GRAMS OF ALCOHOL PER 100 MILLILITERS OF BLOOD; OR

(2) THE NUMBER OF GRAMS OF ALCOHOL PER 210 LITERS OF BREATH.

"BOAT TRAILER" MEANS A VEHICLE THAT IS:

(1) DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTED TO TRANSPORT A BOAT USED FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES; AND

(2) OF A SIZE AND WEIGHT THAT DOES NOT REQUIRE A SPECIAL HIGHWAY MOVEMENT PERMIT WHEN TOWED BY A MOTOR VEHICLE.

"COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE" AND "CDL" MEANS A LICENSE ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 16, SUBTITLE 8 OF THIS ARTICLE OR BY ANOTHER STATE PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY ACT OF 1986 TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHICH AUTHORIZES THE INDIVIDUAL TO DRIVE A CLASS OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.

(A) "COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE" AND "CMV" MEANS A MOTOR VEHICLE OR COMBINATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES USED TO TRANSPORT PASSENGERS OR PROPERTY, IF THE MOTOR VEHICLE:

(1) HAS A GROSS COMBINATION WEIGHT RATING OF 26,001 OR MORE POUNDS INCLUSIVE OF A TOWED UNIT WITH-A-GROSS-VEHICLE WEIGHT-RATING-OF-MORE-THAN-10,000-POUNDS;

(2) HAS A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING OF 26,001 OR MORE POUNDS;

(3) IS DESIGNED TO TRANSPORT 16 OR MORE PASSENGERS, INCLUDING THE DRIVER; OR

(4) IS OF ANY SIZE AND IS USED IN THE TRANSPORTATION OF MATERIALS FOUND TO BE HAZARDOUS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS TRANSPORTATION ACT AND WHICH REQUIRES THE MOTOR VEHICLE TO BE PLACARDED UNDER HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REGULATIONS (49 CFR PART 172, SUBPART F).

(B) "COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE" AND "CMV" DOES NOT INCLUDE A VEHICLE THAT IS:

(1) (I) CONTROLLED AND OPERATED BY A FARMER;
