

(b) An individual may drive a Type II school vehicle if:

(1) He is at least 18 years old;

(2) He holds a driver's license issued under this subtitle of a class that authorizes him to drive the particular type of vehicle; and

(3) He passes an appropriate medical examination.

(A) (1) A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO DRIVE ~~ANY COMBINATION OF VEHICLES WITH A GROSS COMBINATION WEIGHT RATING (GCWR) OF 26,001 OR MORE POUNDS IF THE GVWR OF THE VEHICLES BEING TOWED IS IN EXCESS OF 10,000 POUNDS~~ COMBINATIONS OF CLASS F (TRACTOR) AND CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLES AND ANY VEHICLE THAT A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS B DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES ITS HOLDER TO DRIVE, EXCEPT:

(I) COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES; AND

(II) ~~MOBILE CRANES; AND~~

~~+++~~ MOTORCYCLES.

(2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ISSUED A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON ANY HIGHWAY IN THIS STATE UNLESS A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE INDIVIDUAL TO DRIVE A VEHICLE OF THE CLASS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS DRIVING OR ATTEMPTING TO DRIVE.

(B) (1) A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS B DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO DRIVE ANY SINGLE VEHICLE OR COMBINATIONS OF VEHICLES WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR) (GVW) OR GROSS COMBINATION WEIGHT (GCW) OF 26,001 POUNDS AND MORE, ANY SUCH VEHICLE TOWING A VEHICLE NOT IN EXCESS OF 10,000 POUNDS GVWR AND ANY VEHICLE THAT A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS C DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES ITS HOLDER TO DRIVE, EXCEPT:

(I) COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES;
