- (A) (1) A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO DRIVE ANY-COMBINATION-OF-VEHICLES-WITH-A-GROSS COMBINATION-WEIGHT-RATING-(GCWR)-OF-26,001-OR-MORE-POUNDS-IF--THE GVWR--OF-THE-VEHICLES-BEING-TOWED-IS-IN-EXCESS-OF-10,000-POUNDS COMBINATIONS OF CLASS F (TRACTOR) AND CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLES AND ANY VEHICLE THAT A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS B DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES ITS HOLDER TO DRIVE, EXCEPT:
  - (I) COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLES; AND
  - (II) MOBILE-CRANES;-AND

- (2) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ISSUED A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT DRIVE OR ATTEMPT TO DRIVE A MOTOR VEHICLE ON ANY HIGHWAY IN THIS STATE UNLESS A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE INDIVIDUAL TO DRIVE A VEHICLE OF THE CLASS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS DRIVING OR ATTEMPTING TO DRIVE.
- (B) (1) A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS B DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO DRIVE ANY SINGLE VEHICLE OR COMBINATIONS OF VEHICLES WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING-(GVWR) (GVW) OR GROSS COMBINATION WEIGHT (GCW) OF 26,001 POUNDS AND MORE; ANY-SUCH VEHICLE THAT A NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS C DRIVER'S LICENSE AUTHORIZES ITS HOLDER TO DRIVE, EXCEPT:
