- (b) (1) Each license issued by the Administration shall be identified clearly as to its specific class. A Class [E] M license may be issued in combination with any one of the other classes.
- (2) The Administration shall assign an identifying number to each license it issues.
- (3) To the extent provided by federal law, the Administration may use a driver's social security number as an identifying number for a driver's license.
- (c) Each NONCOMMERCIAL CLASS A, B, C, OR M license issued by the Administration:
- (1) Shall be of the size, design, and content that the Administration specifies;

(2) Shall include:

- (i) The name and residence address of the licensee;
 - (ii) The date of birth of the licensee;
- (iii) A description of the licensee, which shall include the height, weight, and sex of the licensee;
- (iv) The type or class of vehicles that the license authorizes the licensee to drive;
- (v) The signature and seal of the issuing agent; and

(3) Shall include:

- years, a profile photograph of the licensee; or
- (ii) If the licensee is at least 21 years old, a frontal photograph of the licensee.
- (d) (1) A license is not valid unless the licensee signs his name on it in his usual signature.
- (2) When issued and signed, a driver's license authorizes the licensee to drive any vehicle of the type or class specified on it, subject to any restrictions endorsed on the license.
