(d) (1) Subject to the regulations adopted under this subtitle, any resident of this State who possesses a valid Class E OR CLASS M driver's license, a Class E OR CLASS M learner's INSTRUCTIONAL permit, or is eligible for a [Class E] CLASS M learner's INSTRUCTIONAL permit, may enroll in a course.

(b) There shall be deposited in the Motorcycle Safety Program Account, and disbursed in accordance with this section, the following:

(1) \$5.00 for each annual motorcycle registration fee collected under § 13-915(b) of this article; and

(2) All fees collected for the issuance of new [Class E] CLASS M drivers' licenses under § 16-111.1(a) of this article.

SUBTITLE 8. MARYLAND COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE ACT

16-801.

THIS SUBTITLE MAY BE CITED AS THE MARYLAND COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE ACT.

16-802.

(A) THE PURPOSE OF THIS SUBTITLE IS TO IMPLEMENT THE FEDERAL COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY ACT OF 1986 (TITLE XII OF PUBLIC LAW 99-570) AND REDUCE OR PREVENT HEAVY AND COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENTS, FATALITIES, AND INJURIES BY:

(1) DISQUALIFYING DRIVERS FOR CERTAIN CRIMINAL OFFENSES AND SERIOUS TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS; AND

(2) STRENGTHENING LICENSING AND TESTING STANDARDS.

(B) THIS SUBTITLE IS A REMEDIAL LAW AND SHALL BE LIBERALLY CONSTRUED TO PROMOTE THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE.

(C) TO THE EXTENT THAT THIS SUBTITLE CONFLICTS WITH OTHER SUBTITLES OF THIS TITLE, THIS SUBTITLE PREVAILS.

(D) WHERE THIS SUBTITLE IS SILENT, THE PROVISIONS OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW APPLY.
