(B) WITH THE ADVICE OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS CONCERNING THE QUALIFICATIONS OF SCHOOL VEHICLE DRIVERS.

- (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTIONS (B), (C), AND (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT ISSUE A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT TO ANY INDIVIDUAL:
 - (1) WHO IS NOT A RESIDENT OF MARYLAND; AND
 - (2) WHO IS NOT AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE.
- (B) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A CLASS A, B, OR C COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 21, IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE. THE LICENSE:
- (I) MAY NOT INCLUDE A HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ENDORSEMENT;
- (II) MAY NOT BE VALID FOR COMMERCIAL INTERSTATE OPERATION EXCEPT AS PERMITTED BY 49 CFR PARTS 390 TO 399; AND
- (III) SHALL BE VALID FOR COMMERCIAL INTRASTATE AND ALL NONCOMMERCIAL OPERATION.
- (2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A CLASS B COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 18, IF THE INDIVIDUAL MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION. THE LICENSE:
- (I) MAY NOT INCLUDE A HAZARDOUS MATERIALS ENDORSEMENT;
- (II) MAY NOT INCLUDE A PASSENGER VEHICLE ENDORSEMENT;
- (III) MAY NOT BE VALID FOR COMMERCIAL INTERSTATE OPERATION EXCEPT AS PERMITTED BY 49 CFR PARTS 390 TO 399; AND
- (IV) SHALL BE VALID FOR COMMERCIAL INTRASTATE AND ALL NONCOMMERCIAL OPERATION.
- (C) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNDER THE AGE OF 18, IF THE INDIVIDUAL IS AT LEAST 16 YEARS OLD AND HAS COMPLETED SATISFACTORILY A DRIVER'S EDUCATION COURSE APPROVED UNDER SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS TITLE.
