Article - Education Section 16-205(d) Annotated Code of Maryland (1985 Replacement Volume and 1988 Supplement)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

16-205.

- (d) (1) For purposes of this subsection, "displaced homemaker" is an individual who:
  - Is [over 35] 18 30 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER; (i)
- (ii) Has worked for the family in the family home:
  - (iii) Is not gainfully employed;
- (iv) Has had, or would have, difficulty finding employment;
- (v) 1. Has depended on the income of a family lost that income as the result of separation, member and has divorce, or the death or disability of that family member; or
- 2. Has depended on government assistance as the parent of dependent children and is no longer eligible for such assistance; and
  - (vi) Has an annual income that does not exceed:
- The federal Office of Management and Budget poverty income guidelines; or
- The United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, 70 percent lower living standard income level.
- (2) (i) Any resident of this State who is a displaced and who enrolls in any class which is eligible under § 16-403 of this title for State support at the community college:
- Shall be exempt from payment of 1. tuition; and
- 2. Shall be counted in full-time equivalent enrollment under § 16-403 of this enrolled in any class that is eligible for State support.
