(4) IN THE CASE OF A CLASS E TRUCK WITH A MANUFACTURER'S RATING OR REGISTERED GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT OF MORE THAN 10,000 POUNDS BUT NOT MORE THAN 18,000 POUNDS, 30 INCHES.

the purpose of prohibiting a person from operating on a FOR highway a motor vehicle equipped with a power booster system except under certain circumstances; requiring motor vehicles with equipped power booster systems display to identification decals in a certain manner; establishing certain criminal and administrative penalties; defining a certain term; authorizing the Motor-Vehicle-Administration Office of the Fire Marshal to adopt certain regulations; providing for fees for identification decals; and generally relating to power booster systems in motor vehicles.
