- (3) DISPLAYED--AS--REQUIRED--BY-THE-ADMINISTRATION IS ATTACHED TO THE LEFT FRONT AND RIGHT REAR BUMPER OF THE VEHICLE.
- (E) THE ADMINISTRATION OFFICE OF THE FIRE MARSHAL MAY ADOPTREGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.
- (F) THE OFFICE OF THE FIRE MARSHAL OR NITROUS OXIDE INDUSTRY SOURCE THAT ISSUES THE VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION DECAL SHALL MAY CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A VEHICLE IDENTIFICATION DECAL NOT TO EXCEED THE REASONABLE COST OF PREPARATION AND DISTRIBUTION.

AN ACT concerning

FOR the purpose of altering—the—penalties—for—charging—or receiving—prohibited—compensation—in—connection—with—an adoption; making it a misdemeanor subject to certain penalties for certain—persons a penson to sell, barter, or trade or offer to sell, barter, or trade certain—children a child for money, property, or anything of value; and generally relating to baby—selling—and—baby—brokering prohibitions against a sale, barter, or trade or an offer to sell, barter, or trade a child for anything of value.
