

(A) IN COOPERATION WITH THE REGISTERS, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL:

(1) MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC BASIC INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS TO ASSIST THE PUBLIC IN THE PROCEDURE AND PREPARATION OF FORMS FOR PROBATE; AND

(2) REVIEW THE INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS ON A REGULAR BASIS AND UPDATE THEM AS NECESSARY.

(B) THE REGISTERS AND DESIGNATED EMPLOYEES OF THE REGISTERS SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE THE MATERIALS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE PUBLIC; AND

(2) ASSIST AND ADVISE ANY PERSON WHO REQUESTS ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE IN THE PREPARATION OF ANY FORMS OR IN CARRYING OUT THE PROCEDURES PROVIDED FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PROBATE IN UNCONTESTED MATTERS UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

~~(C) A REGISTER, A DESIGNATED EMPLOYEE OF THE REGISTER, OR GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY THE POLITICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT BE LIABLE TO ANY PERSON WITH RESPECT TO ANY ASSISTANCE OR ADVICE PROVIDED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, EXCEPT IN CASES OF GROSS NEGLIGENCE.~~
