

CHAPTER 313

(Senate Bill 141)

AN ACT concerning

Land Surveyors - Reexamination Fee

FOR the purpose of altering the reexamination fee for persons wishing to retake the examination to become licensed as professional land surveyors or property line surveyors; eliminating a certain waiting period for the reexamination of certain persons applying for licensure as property line surveyors under certain circumstances; and providing for effective dates.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 56 - Licenses

(d) (1) An applicant, after a failure, may take another examination by filing a petition with the Board, on a form issued by the Board, indicating the applicant's desire to take again the examination. The petition shall be accompanied [with] BY a reexamination fee [not to exceed \$25] THAT SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE APPROPRIATE APPLICATION FEE FOR A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR AS SET FORTH IN § 336(A) OF THIS ARTICLE. The fee may not be refunded if the applicant does not take the examination but [the] ANY fee retained shall be applied to an examination subsequently taken.

A (e) On the failure of a third examination, an applicant FOR PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR LICENSE, may not apply for
