- (2) A FAMILY DAY CARE HOME REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER PART V OF THIS SUBTITLE;
- [(2)] (3) a child care home required to be licensed under Title 5 of this article or under Article 83C;
- [(3)] (4) a child care institution required to be licensed under Title 5 of this article or under Article 83C;
- [(4)] (5) a juvenile detention, correction, or treatment facility provided for in Article 83C;
- [(5)] (6) a public school as defined in Title 1 of the Education Article;
- [(6)] (7) a private or nonpublic school required to report annually to the State Board of Education under Title 2 of the Education Article;
- [(7)] (8) a foster care family home or group facility as defined under Ti of this article;
- [(8)] (9) a recreation center or recreation program operated by State or local government primarily serving minors; or
- [(9)] (10) a day or overnight camp, as defined in Title 10, Subtitle 16 of the Code of Maryland Regulations, primarily serving minors.
- (C) THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS SHALL OBTAIN A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION UNDER THIS PART VI:
- (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS SEEKING TO ADOPT A CHILD THROUGH A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES OR LICENSED CHILD PLACEMENT AGENCY;
- (2) AN ADULT RELATIVE WITH WHOM A CHILD, COMMITTED TO A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, IS PLACED BY THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES; AND
- (3) ANY ADULT KNOWN BY A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO BE RESIDING IN A:
- (I) FAMILY DAY CARE HOME REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER TITLE 5 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR
- (II) HOME OF AN ADULT RELATIVE OF A CHILD WITH WHOM THE CHILD, COMMITTED TO A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES, IS PLACED BY THE LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES.
