(3) A LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES THAT IN GOOD FAITH RELIES ON A CRIMINAL BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION TO MAKE A DECISION CONCERNING THE PLACEMENT OF A CHILD COMMITTED TO IT, INCLUDING A DECISION TO REMOVE A CHILD FROM A PARTICULAR FACILITY OR HOME; AND

[(3)] (4) a State or local agency that in good faith participates in the making of a criminal background investigation of an employee or employer.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 325

(Senate Bill 215)

AN ACT concerning

Radiation Control - License Fees - State Radiation Control Fund

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of the Environment to adopt rules and regulations to establish a fee schedule for licenses and registrations issued under the Radiation Control Act; requiring the Department to consult with certain persons in establishing the fee schedule; providing certain criteria for the establishment of the fee schedule; creating a State Radiation Control Fund; providing that funds collected under the Maryland Radiation Act go into the State Radiation Control Fund; providing for use of the Fund; requiring the Department to prepare a certain annual report and adopt certain regulations relating to the management and use of money in the Fund; and generally relating to radiation control.
