

(2) Establish inspection procedures and a schedule for the periodic inspection and certification of radiation machines;

(3) Establish a BIENNIAL fee schedule IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 8-301(B)(1)(III) OF THIS SUBTITLE that is sufficient only to cover the costs TO THE DEPARTMENT of [certification to the Department] ISSUING THE CERTIFICATE AND REGULATING THE USE OF RADIATION; and

(4) Provide for penalties for the failure to certify radiation machines.

8-306.

(A) THERE IS A STATE RADIATION CONTROL FUND.

(B) ALL GENERAL LICENSE FEES, SPECIFIC LICENSE FEES, REGISTRATION FEES, RADIATION MACHINE CERTIFICATION FEES, AND ALL FUNDS COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS TITLE, INCLUDING ANY CIVIL PENALTIES, SETTLEMENTS, OR FINES, SHALL BE PAID INTO THE STATE RADIATION CONTROL FUND.

(C) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL USE THE STATE RADIATION CONTROL FUND FOR ACTIVITIES THAT ARE RELATED TO IDENTIFYING, MONITORING, AND CONTROLLING SOURCES OF RADIATION, INCLUDING RADIATION MACHINES, AND FOR PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT OF THESE ACTIVITIES.

(D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE MANAGEMENT AND USE OF THE MONEY IN THE FUND.

(E) AT THE END OF THE FISCAL YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PREPARE AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE STATE RADIATION CONTROL FUND THAT INCLUDES AN ACCOUNTING OF ALL FINANCIAL RECEIPTS AND EXPENDITURES TO AND FROM THE FUND AND SHALL:

(1) PROVIDE A COPY OF THE REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, AS PROVIDED UNDER § 2-1312 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE; AND

(2) UPON REQUEST, MAKE THE REPORT AVAILABLE TO THE LICENSE HOLDERS UNDER THIS TITLE.
