

(a) The powers and duties of the Chesapeake Bay Trust shall rest in and be exercised by a board of [15] 19 trustees.

(b) The Board of Trustees shall consist of:

(1) The President of the Senate, ex officio;

(2) The Speaker of the House, ex officio;

(3) The Secretaries of Agriculture, the Environment, and Natural Resources, ex officio, or their designees; and

(4) [10] 14 individuals appointed by the Governor[, who] AS FOLLOWS:

(I) 8 shall represent the interests of local government, education, [business,] environmental conservation, and the general public; AND

(II) 6 SHALL REPRESENT THE BUSINESS COMMUNITY.

The Trust shall terminate on July 1, 1989. Any funds remaining to the credit of the Trust after that date shall be held by the State Treasurer until legislation is enacted providing for the disposition of the funds.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 329

(Senate Bill 277)

AN ACT concerning
