CHAPTER 330

(Senate Bill 297)

AN ACT concerning

Medical Laboratories - Permit Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring certain individual physicians and physician groups to obtain a permit to operate a medical laboratory under certain circumstances; ~~authorizing~~ requiring the Department Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to issue exceptions to the permit requirements if certain conditions are satisfied; requiring the Secretary to set certain fees; making certain clarifying changes; defining certain terms; requiring the Secretary to appoint a certain committee and a chairman for that committee; and generally relating to the licensure of medical laboratories.
