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- A physician or group practice that is [exempted] EXCEPTED from the permit requirements of this subtitle shall:
- (1) [Demonstrate] ENROLL IN AND CONTINUE TO DEMONSTRATE satisfactory performance in a proficiency testing program APPROVED BY THE SECRETARY in applicable laboratory procedures before the physician performs any medical laboratory procedure; or
- (2) [Satisfy the requirements set] PERFORM OR PERSONALLY SUPERVISE ONLY THOSE LABORATORY PROCEDURES APPROVED by the Secretary through rules and regulations, AS NOT REQUIRING ENROLLMENT AND CONTINUED SATISFACTORY PERFORMANCE IN AN APPROVED PROFICIENCY TESTING PROGRAM.
