TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES THAT ANY DISABILITY BENEFICIARY IS ENGAGED IN OR IS ABLE TO ENGAGE IN A GAINFUL OCCUPATION PAYING MORE THAN THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN HIS OR HER RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE AT THE TIME OF HIS OR HER RETIREMENT AND HIS OR HER AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION PLUS \$3,000, AND IF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES CONCURS IN THE REPORT, THEN THE AMOUNT OF THE PENSION SHALL BE REDUCED.

(III) IF THE BENEFICIARY'S EARNING CAPACITY IS LATER CHANGED, THE AMOUNT OF HIS OR HER PENSION MAY BE FURTHER MODIFIED, PROVIDED THAT THE NEW PENSION MAY NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF THE PENSION ORIGINALLY GRANTED.

AT A SALARY LESS THAN THE AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION UPON THE BASIS OF WHICH HE OR SHE WAS RETIRED SHALL NOT BECOME A MEMBER OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNTIL HIS OR HER SALARY IS AT LEAST EQUAL TO SUCH AVERAGE FINAL COMPENSATION.

REQUIRED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II) AND ALLOWED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (III) OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL BE ONE DOLLAR FOR EVERY TWO DOLLARS BY WHICH HIS OR HER CURRENT COMPENSATION EXCEEDS THE LIMITATION PROVIDED UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

## CHAPTER 337

(Senate Bill 460)
