(Senate Bill 808)

AN ACT concerning

Rubble ~~Fill~~ Landfills - Restrictions

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Secretary of the Environment from issuing a permit to certain rubble ~~fill~~ landfills to accept certain materials ~~or goods unless the county where the rubble landfill is located includes certain information in a certain county solid waste management plan; specifying certain materials that may be included in the plan;~~ requiring applicants for permits for rubble ~~fill~~ landfills to give certain additional notice to certain persons; ~~defining a term;~~ and generally relating to rubble ~~fill~~ landfills.
