AN ACT concerning

Rubble Fill Landfills - Restrictions

for the purpose of prohibiting the Secretary of the Environment from issuing a permit to certain rubble fill landfills to accept certain materials or-goods unless the county where the rubble landfill is located includes certain information in a certain county solid waste management plan; specifying certain materials that may be included in the plan; requiring applicants for permits for rubble fill landfills to give certain additional notice to certain persons; defining-a-term; and generally relating to rubble fill landfills.
