## LAWS OF MARYLAND

- [(a)] (D) A [person] RAILROAD COMPANY may not have a common drinking cup or a common towel available for use [in a public place, including a passenger train or boat that carries passengers] ON RAILROAD PROPERTY.
- [(b) The Secretary may adopt reasonable rules and regulations to carry out this section.
- (c) A person who violates any provision of this section or rule or regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$25.]

## [24-203] 103.

- (a) This section does not apply to a railroad locomotive that is used only for yard-switching service.
- (b) The [Secretary] COMMISSIONER may adopt rules and regulations that regulate the sanitary condition of railroad locomotives.
- (c) Before adopting any rule or regulation under this section, the [Department] DIVISION shall announce and hold a public hearing on the subject.
