

(C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS EMPLOYED THROUGH A WORK RELEASE PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL REIMBURSE THE HOWARD COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION FOR:

(1) THE DEPARTMENT'S ESTIMATED COST OF PROVIDING FOOD AND LODGING TO THE INDIVIDUAL; AND

(2) THE ESTIMATED EXPENSES INCURRED BY THE DEPARTMENT BECAUSE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S PARTICIPATION IN THE WORK RELEASE PROGRAM.

(D) (1) IF AN INDIVIDUAL VIOLATES A CONDITION OR PROVISION OF TRUST ESTABLISHED BY THE JUDGE OR BY THE HOWARD COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, THE INDIVIDUAL MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE WORK RELEASE PROGRAM AND ANY EARNED DIMINUTION OF SENTENCE MAY BE CANCELED.

(2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL VIOLATES A TERM OF LEAVE PERMITTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY PROVIDED UNDER THIS SECTION, IT SHALL BE CONSIDERED A VIOLATION OF § 139 OF THIS ARTICLE.

(E) A PRISONER EMPLOYED IN THE COMMUNITY UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE CONSIDERED TO BE AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF HOWARD COUNTY, THE DIRECTOR OF THE HOWARD COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, OR ANY OTHER JUDICIAL OR PUBLIC OFFICER OF THE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
