(B) THE ORDER PROHIBITS SALE OR DISTRIBUTION OF THE PESTICIDE UNTIL THE SECRETARY HAS EVIDENCE THAT THE PESTICIDE IS IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE LAW AND UNTIL THE SECRETARY PROVIDES A WRITTEN RELEASE FROM THE STOP-SALE ORDER.

- (a) Any pesticide distributed, --sold, --offered--for--sale, delivered--for--transportation, --or--transported--in--intrastate commerce-or-between-points-within-the--State--through--any--point outside--of IN the State may be proceeded against in the circuit court of any county, where it is found and seized for confiscation by libel of information, if the pesticide:
 - (1) Is adulterated or misbranded;
 - (2) Is not registered; OR
- (3) Fails to bear on its label the information
 required by this subtitle[; or
- (4) Is a white powder pesticide and is not colored as required under this subtitle].
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
