

Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

37E.

~~IF THE APPOINTMENT TO THE CLASSIFIED POSITION OCCURS WITHIN 1 YEAR FROM THE DATE OF SEPARATION FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OR 1 YEAR FROM THE DATE OF SEPARATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPUTING ANNUAL LEAVE, SICK LEAVE, SALARY CREDIT AND ANY OTHER SERVICE CREDIT, AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS RETURNING TO STATE SERVICE WITH AN AUTHORIZED STATUS OF REINSTATEMENT OR WHO WAS A FORMER PERMANENT CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND SHALL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR TIME EMPLOYED.~~

(A) A FORMER PERMANENT EMPLOYEE OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE OR THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR REINSTATEMENT MUST BE APPOINTED TO A CLASSIFIED POSITION WITHIN 18 MONTHS 7 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF SEPARATION FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S FORMER POSITION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE REINSTATEMENT PRIVILEGES.

(B) A FORMER PERMANENT EMPLOYEE WHO RETURNS TO STATE SERVICE WITH AN AUTHORIZED STATUS OF REINSTATEMENT SHALL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR TIME EMPLOYED PRIOR TO THE DATE OF SEPARATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING:

(1) LONGEVITY STEPS IN THE PAY GRADE APPLICABLE TO THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF THE APPOINTED POSITION;

(2) ANNUAL LEAVE;

(3) SICK LEAVE; AND

(4) SENIORITY RIGHTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
