SECTION BE IΤ ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 64A - Merit System

37E.

IF-THE-APPOINTMENT-TO-THE-CLASSIFIED-POSITION-OCCURS--WITHIN 1-YEAR-FROM-THE-DATE-OF-SEPARATION-FROM-THE-CLASSIFIED-SERVICE-OR 1--YEAR--PROM--THE--DATE--OF--SEPARATION--PROM--THE-UNIVERSITY-OF MARYLAND,-FOR-THE-PURPOSE-OF-COMPUTING-ANNUAL-LEAVE,-SICK--LEAVE, SALARY--EREDIT--AND--ANY-OTHER-SERVICE-EREDIT-AN-EMPLOYEE-WHO-IS RETURNING--TO--STATE--SERVICE--WITH--AN--AUTHORIZED---STATUS---OP REINSTATEMENT--OR--WHO-WAS-A-FORMER-PERMANENT-CLASSIFIED-EMPLOYEE OF-THE-UNIVERSITY-OF--MARYLAND--SHALL-RECEIVE--CREDIT--FOR--TIME EMPLOYED-

- PERMANENT EMPLOYEE OF THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE (A) A FORMER OR THE UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR REINSTATEMENT APPOINTED TO A CLASSIFIED POSITION WITHIN 18-MONTHS 2 YEARS FROM THE DATE OF SEPARATION FROM THE EMPLOYEE'S FORMER POSITION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE REINSTATEMENT PRIVILEGES.
- FORMER PERMANENT EMPLOYEE WHO RETURNS TO STATE SERVICE WITH AN AUTHORIZED STATUS OF REINSTATEMENT SHALL RECEIVE CREDIT FOR TIME EMPLOYED PRIOR TO THE DATE OF SEPARATION FOR PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING:
- LONGEVITY STEPS IN THE PAY GRADE APPLICABLE TO THE JOB CLASSIFICATION OF THE APPOINTED POSITION:
  - (2) ANNUAL LEAVE;
  - (3) SICK LEAVE; AND
  - (4) SENIORITY RIGHTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.
