

[(c)] (D) On receipt of the permit, the person shall affix it to [his] THE vehicle in a conspicuous place.

[(d)] (E) A person may not commit any fraud or make any misrepresentation in applying for a reserved parking space issued under this section or in any certification of fact as to the contents of the application.

[(e)] (F) A person may not commit any fraud or make any misrepresentation in using a permit for a reserved parking space issued under this section.

[(f)] (G) In addition to any other penalty provided by law for a violation of this section, the Administration may refuse to issue a permit or revoke a permit that has been issued.

[(g)] (H) A person aggrieved by a decision or order of the Administration issued under this section may appeal from the decision or order as provided in § 12-209 of this article.

[(h)] (I) After the Administration issues the permit, the Administration shall notify the State Highway Administration or, as to parking spaces in Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Department of ~~Transit--and--Traffic~~ TRANSPORTATION, or, as to parking spaces in Baltimore County, the Baltimore County Department of Traffic Engineering.

[(i)] (J) Except in Baltimore City and Baltimore County, within 30 days after it receives the notification required by subsection [(h)] (I) of this section, the State Highway Administration shall:

(1) Place and maintain at the proper place at least one sturdy upright sign that:

(i) Contains a clear and easily recognizable representation of a wheelchair; and

(ii) Prohibits general public parking in the reserved space; and

(2) [Paint] IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, PAINT a red line on the curb, edge, or side of the roadway, long enough to reserve a space for one Class A (passenger) vehicle.

[(j)] (K) In Baltimore City, the establishment of a reserved parking space shall be subject to approval of the Baltimore City Department of ~~Transit--and--Traffic~~ TRANSPORTATION, in accordance with the charter and public local laws of Baltimore City.
