

(ii) each issue of the permanent supplements to the Code of Maryland Regulations; and

(iii) each issue of the Register; and

(3) to a judge of a State court except the orphans' court, 1 copy of the current Code of Maryland Regulations or the Register that the judge requests.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1989.

CHAPTER 383

(House Bill 136)

AN ACT concerning

Contract Liens - Notice and Filing Requirements

FOR the purpose of requiring certain notice of contract liens be ~~given~~ served by certain mail and personal delivery or posting; requiring the claimant to file contract lien statements within a certain time after certain time periods; and generally relating to notice and filing of contract liens.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Real Property

14-203.

(a) (1) A party seeking to create a lien as the result of a breach of contract shall, within 2 years of a breach of contract, give written notice to the party against whose property the lien is intended to be imposed.
