- REQUEST A HEARING TO BE HELD IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION;
- [(2)] (3) Refer the matter to the Attorney General for civil enforcement under subsection (c) OF THIS SECTION; and
- [(3)] (4) Refer the matter to the appropriate State's attorney for prosecution.

- PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL HOLD A HEARING, IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE REQUEST IS FILED.
- (E) The Secretary of State shall adopt rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of this subtitle.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this-Act-shall take-effect-July-17-1989: the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- Article 41 Governor Executive and Administrative Departments 3-215.
- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE CHARITABLE GIVING INFORMATION PROGRAM.
- (B) THERE IS A CHARITABLE GIVING INFORMATION PROGRAM WITHIN THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE.
- (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ABOUT CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS AND SOLICITATIONS TO ENABLE THE PUBLIC TO:
- (1) RECOGNIZE UNLAWFUL, MISLEADING, DECEPTIVE, OR FRAUDULENT SOLICITATIONS; AND
- CONCERNING DONATIONS TO CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS.
 - (D) THE PROGRAM SHALL INFORM THE PUBLIC OF:
- (1) THE LAWS AND REGULATIONS DEALING WITH CHARITABLE ORGANIZATIONS AND SOLICITATIONS, INCLUDING REGISTRATION
