## 6-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

- (B) ASSIGNMENT OF LOCAL LICENSE.
- (1) "ASSIGNMENT OF LOCAL LICENSE" MEANS ANY PROCEDURE BY WHICH A LICENSEE GRANTS TO ANOTHER PERSON A RIGHT TO USE A LOCAL LICENSE TO ENABLE THAT PERSON TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING ELECTRICAL SERVICES.
- (2) "ASSIGNMENT OF LOCAL LICENSE" INCLUDES ANY PROCEDURE BY WHICH:
- (I) A LICENSEE AGREES TO BE THE REPRESENTATIVE OF ANOTHER PERSON; AND
- (II) BY VIRTUE OF THAT AGREEMENT, THE OTHER PERSON IS AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF PROVIDING ELECTRICAL SERVICES.
