CHAPTER 438

(House Bill 795)

AN ACT concerning

Vehicle Laws - Young Drivers - Alcohol Restriction

FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration indicate on the driver's license of a licensee under a certain age that a certain alcohol restriction has been imposed on the licensee; clarifying language; providing for the construction and application of this Act; and generally relating to alcohol restrictions imposed on young drivers.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

16-113.

- (b) (1) Notwithstanding the licensee's driving record, the Administration shall impose on each licensee under the age of 21 years an alcohol restriction that prohibits the licensee from driving or attempting to drive a motor vehicle with 0.02 percent or more by weight of alcohol in the licensee's blood.
- (2) An alcohol restriction imposed under this subsection expires when the licensee reaches the age of 21 years.
