SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(d) In Allegany County the [clerk of the court, upon approval of the board, upon application therefor, in such form as may be prescribed by said board, signed and sworn to,] BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS shall have authority to grant special licenses of any class, except manufacturer's and wholesaler's, which shall entitle the holder thereof to exercise any of the privileges conferred by the respective classes of licenses at any bona fide entertainment held or conducted by any club, society, or association at the place therein described, for a period not exceeding seven consecutive days from the effective date thereof, upon the payment of a fee of \$20 per day for any beer or beer and light wine license, or a fee of [fifty dollars (\$50.00)] \$50 per day, for not more than fourteen consecutive days, for any beer,
